

## FEBS/EMBO Women in Science Award 2010

The Federation of European Biochemical Societies (FEBS) and the European Molecular Biology Organization (EMBO) are pleased to announce the second call for nominations for the FEBS/EMBO Women in Science Award 2010. The deadline for nominations has been extended to **15 October 2009**.

The aim of this award is to highlight major contributions made by female scientists and to present inspiring role models for future generations of women in science.

Nominees should be excellent women scientists, who have made outstanding contributions to life sciences research in the last 5 years, and who have significantly advanced our understanding of a particular discipline.

Their research should be based in one of the FEBS and EMBO associated countries and can be in any area of the life sciences including agricultural and biomedical research.

The winner will be honoured at the next FEBS Congress, in Gothenburg (2010), where she will receive the award of 10,000 EUR and present a special plenary lecture.
